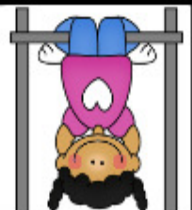

What We're Learning

Reading: We will begin Unit 5 this week called “I Wish, I Hope, I Pray”. In this unit we will explore and consider that what we choose to dream about, hope for, and pray about can affect our own lives both now and in the future.
