Sarnia Sting / Chuck the Puck Fundraiser:

We are planning a Sarnia Sting hockey night as a school. The Sarnia Sting is an OHL team where future NHL players have played. The date is set: Friday February 15, starting at 7:05 pm against the Windsor Spitfires.

Every family is being asked to sell tickets. As a school we have committed to sell a minimum of 75 tickets. For every ticket we sell, a portion goes back to the school. Youth tickets are \$15 (ages 4-12), over 12 the cost is \$25. This gets you into the hockey game, seats with your fellow Christian school families, and a chance to win prizes. Every adult ticket includes 3 chances to win and every youth ticket has 1 chance to win!

The Chuck the Puck portion of the night is 100% back to the school. So this is where we challenge every family to sell 60 pucks! If we can do that our school will get over \$4000!! There are 3 pucks included with every adult ticket already. To purchase on their own, pucks are \$2 a puck or 3 for \$5. Tracking sheets were sent home; more are available from school. They do not need to attend the game to win, so ask everyone you know: neighbours, family, friends, church families, etc. There is no limit as to how many pucks a

person would like to purchase.

Prizes are being gathered and are worth at least \$100; there will be 3-4 prizes. During the game, some students will have a chance to throw all the purchased pucks on the ice and then winners will be determined. Every puck presold will be assigned a number prior to the game, and pucks are available to purchase thru the game as well.
