## Hotdog Days

Our first hotdog day is **this Thursday, September 26**. Junior and Senior Kindergarten students are asked to bring in 1 dozen treats per student, ready to sell (eg. baked goods - cut into pieces; pretzels - put into baggies, etc.). No candy please.

Snacks are priced at 25¢ each; money raised goes toward year end class trips.

In an effort to streamline the ordering process and make it more convenient for parents, we have asked parents to pay now for hotdogs. **I am still missing quite a few orders.**

There are 7 hot dog days in this school year (September 26, October 31, November 28, January 30, February 27, March 26 and April 23). If your child likes 1 hot dog per hot dog day, you would send in \$8.75 (7 x 1.25) and they will automatically receive one hot dog without any further need for you to order and send in exact change each month. If you have 2 children and one likes 2 hot dogs and the other 1 hot dog, you would send in \$26.25 (3x\$1.25x7). And so on. **Payment should be made by cash or cheque before September 25.**
