Help Needed!!

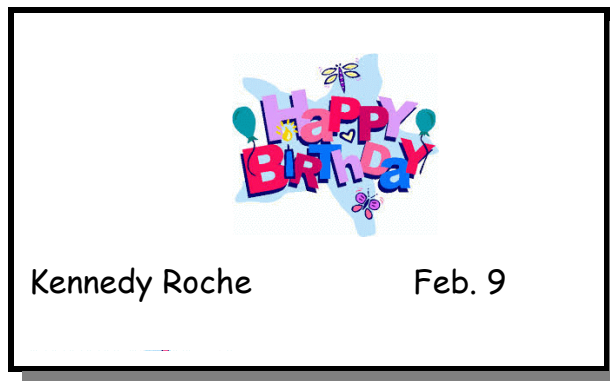
