# **Policy Corner**

WCS has a Homework Policy that has been Board approved, and is listed on our website: www.wallaceburgchristianschool.com/Policies/600-Students/607-Homework%20Policy.pdf We encourage you to read through the entire policy; listed below are some points by grades that all parents need to be familiar with. Thank you for reading them!

### **Definition of Homework**

- 1. Unfinished classroom work
- 2. Assigned work such as:
  - 1. Research
  - 2. Making models
  - 3. Additional practice work
  - 4. Review of math facts, spelling words, memory work, sight words
  - 5. Reading
  - 6. Studying for tests

### **Guidelines for Homework**

Most of the work assigned to the students should be done at school. However, some homework will be assigned on a daily basis, within these general rules:

### **Grades JK-SK**

Letter and sound recognition - 5 minute minimum

Counting and number recognition - 5 minute minimum

Practice Sight Words - 5 minute minimum

Read Decodable Book - 5 minute minimum

Practice Memory Work - 5 minute minimum

Incomplete class work may also be sent home to be finished. It is expected that this will be returned the next school day unless specified by the teacher.

#### Grades 1-2

Practice Sight Words - 5 minute minimum

Practice Spelling Words - 5 minute minimum

Practice Math Facts - 5 minute minimum

Read an AR book - 10 minute minimum

Practice Memory Work - 5 minute minimum

Incomplete class work may also be sent home to be finished. It is expected that this will be returned the next school day unless specified by the teacher.

### Grades 3-4

Practice Spelling Words - 5 minute minimum

Practice Math Facts - 5 minute minimum

Read an AR book - 15 minute minimum

Practice Memory Work - 5 minute minimum

Incomplete class work may also be sent home to be finished. It is expected that this will be returned the next school day unless specified by the teacher.

### Grade 5-6

Practice Spelling Words - 5 minute minimum

Practice Math Facts - 5 minute minimum

(If specified by teacher)

Read an AR book - 20 minute minimum

Practice Memory Work - 5 minute minimum

Incomplete class work may also be sent home to be finished. It is expected that this will be returned the next school day unless specified by the teacher.

### Grade 7-8

Practice Spelling Words - 10 minute minimum

Read an AR book - 25 minute minimum

Practice Memory Work - 10 minute minimum

Incomplete class work may also be sent home to be finished. It is expected that this will be returned the next school day unless specified by the teacher.

Note: Incomplete homework does fall under our Discipline Policy and a Student Incident Report (SIR) will be issued.
